TASTING NOTE

Warm baking spices set the stage for a rich, layered palate. Flavors of red cherry, blackberry, and black plum are complemented by hints of toffee, vanilla, and dark chocolate. Full-bodied with soft, well-integrated tannins, this wine showcases superb balance and depth. The oak influence is beautifully woven throughout. Already aging gracefully, it promises continued elegance in the years to come.

VINEYARD

The Cabernet fruit came from our Estate Block 7 vineyard. The deep, gravelly soils in this vineyard promote low to moderate vigor, encouraging the vines to produce rich, concentrated fruit. Water drains quickly in this soil which compels deep root growth for accessing water and nutrients found in the rich subsoils below.

VINTAGE

Seasonable warm temperatures and cool nights led to a long growing season for 2018. The Livermore Valley did not see any late rains which allowed our winemaking team to let the fruit hang and mature slowly. This produced beautifully ripe fruit with intense rich flavor concentration. 2018 is sure to be a vintage to remember.

TASTING NOTE

Cabernet Franc's herbaceous aromatics shine in this blend with Cabernet Sauvignon. Juniper, perfumed florals, and blueberry lead into a bramble medley of strawberry, blackberry, and subtle herbs. Balanced structure and refined tannins create a smooth, lingering finish.

VINEYARD

The Cabernet fruit came from our Estate Block 7 vineyard. The deep, gravelly soils in this vineyard promote low to moderate vigor, encouraging the vines to produce rich, concentrated fruit. Water drains quickly in this soil which compels deep root growth for accessing water and nutrients found in the rich subsoils below. The Cabernet Franc is from Block 15.

VINTAGE

The growing season was consistent and mild. Signs pointed to an early harvest until a late August/early September heat wave pushed ripening in some blocks, resulting in a quickened harvest pace. But September rain brought a sigh of relief, refreshing the vines and allowing more hang time for the remaining grapes. Overall, the result was concentrated and flavorful fruit, creating great acid balance.

TASTING NOTE

Beautifully structured, this blend showcases the depth of Cabernet Sauvignon and the bold character of Petit Verdot. Vibrant floral aromas of violet and lavender introduce a palate of blackberry, black olive, and black licorice. Silky tannins create a smooth, balanced mouthfeel, while a long finish leaves a strong impression.

VINEYARD

The Cabernet fruit came from our Estate Block 7 vineyard. The deep, gravelly soils in this vineyard promote low to moderate vigor, encouraging the vines to produce rich, concentrated fruit. Water drains quickly in this soil which compels deep root growth for accessing water and nutrients found in the rich subsoils below. The Petit Verdot is from Block 17.

VINTAGE

The growing season was consistent and mild. Signs pointed to an early harvest until a late August/early September heat wave pushed ripening in some blocks, resulting in a quickened harvest pace.
